Special Needs Access

Level access is available in the grounds, museum displays and railway. Wheelchair loan is available on request and audio interpretation and hands-on displays are featured throughout the exhibitions. A staff assisted lift allows access to the beam engine house. There is an accessible toilet and baby changing facilities.

Fire Safety Restrictions

The museum is based in a listed building, which makes it very difficult to make alterations in respect of fire escape routes. During busy Special Event Days it may be necessary to limit numbers in the Beam Engine house.

How to get to APS

The Abbey Pumping Station, Leicester LE4 5PX (Grid reference SK588067) is about 1 mile north of Leicester City centre near Beaumont Leys. Situated on the Riverside Walk and Sustrans cycleway, it is adjacent to the National Space Centre.

Bus 54, leave from Haymarket Bus Station, currently stand HY. Park and Ride electric bus 303 from Birstall or City Centre, alight at ASDA stop, not on Sundays. Outer city centre circular route number 40 clockwise/anticlockwise. Nearest stop Thurcaston Road/Abbey Lane junction. Not on Sundays. 'Skylink' service from Leicester, Loughborough and Derby, will drop off and pickup at the junction of Corporation Road and Abbey Lane. Visit: <https://skylink.co.uk>



Follow the Riverside Walk or Abbey Lane (A6). An 8 minute walk from Abbey Lane bus stop.



Parking (including Disabled parking) is available on the National Space Centre car park, Pay and Display.

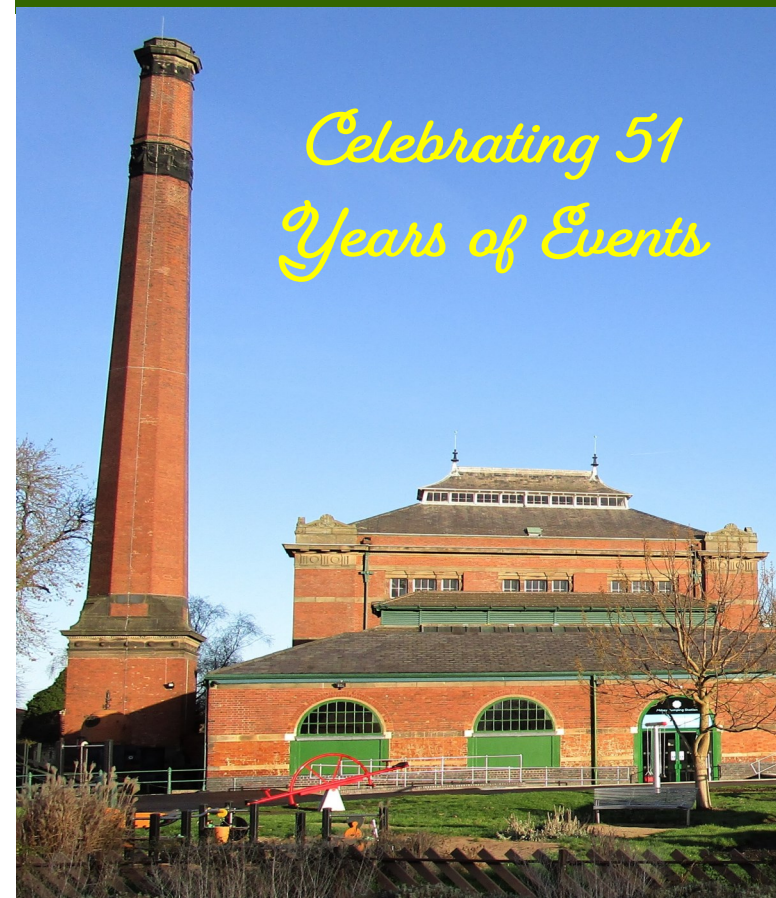


Follow Sustrans cycle route 6 along Riverside Walk.

This is your chance to take a full guided tour of the Beam Engine House (only open to tour groups) while the engine is working. You can question the guides on the engines (max group size 20).

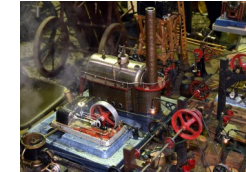
